**School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter**

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2018-19 educational progress for the Adams School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2018-19 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not given one of these titles.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. **PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL:** In district students are enrolled automatically. School-of-choice openings, if any, are posted each year in July and January. Students are taken through the school-of-choice program until positions are filled or the deadline occurs.
2. **THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN:**  
We are in the fourth year of our plan. The plan will expire in 2021.
3. **A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL:** There are no specialized schools in our district.

4. IDENTIFY HOW TO ACCESS A COPY OF THE CORE CURRICULUM, A DESCRIPTION OF ITS IMPLEMENTATION, AND AN EXPLANATION OF THE VARIANCES FROM THE STATE'S MODE: A copy of the core curriculum is available from the Michigan Department of Education, from Adams School, or from the Huron Intermediate School District. Adams School follows the Michigan Common Core State Standards in all subject areas that are taught at the school.
5. THE AGGREGATE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT RESULTS FOR ANY LOCAL COMPETENCY TESTS OR NATIONALLY NORMED ACHIEVEMENT TESTS: Due to confidentiality concerns, this information cannot be reported in this format because of the limited number of available scores. Individual student scores are available to parents upon request and are sent home once tests are administered.
6. IDENTIFY THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF STUDENTS REPRESENTED BY PARENTS AT PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES: Nineteen of 1/9 students were represented by parents at parent teacher conferences in 18/19.

The faculty and board are proud of the effort the children have shown when taking the state mandated tests.
